



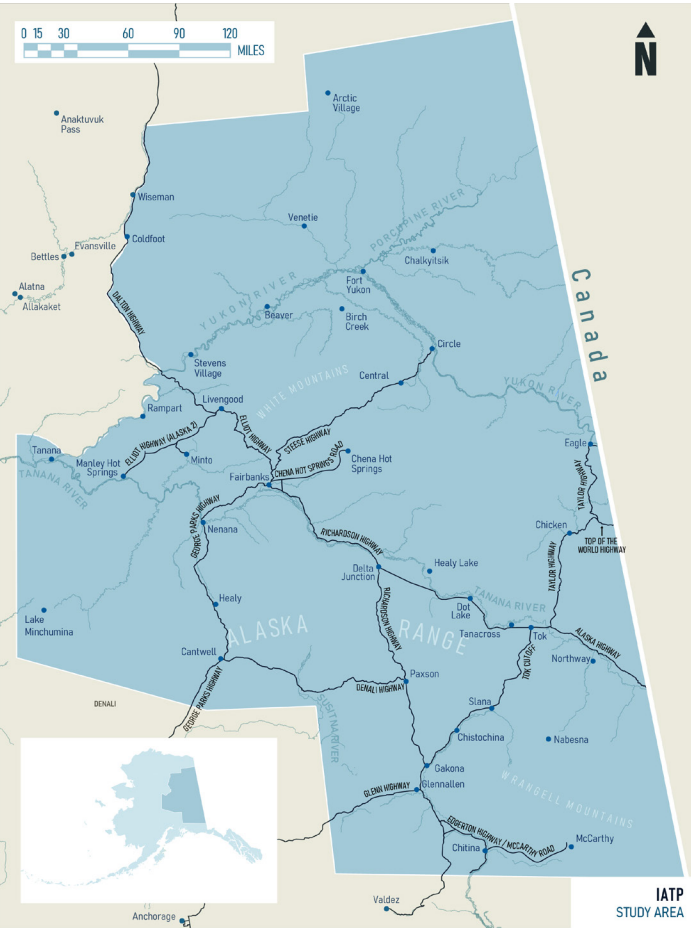

Project Overview

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) is updating the Interior Alaska Transportation Plan (IATP), a 20-year regional multimodal transportation plan that will guide future public investments in transportation infrastructure in the interior Alaska region.

Why are we updating the IATP?

A regional transportation plan supports delivery of transportation improvements. It is a guide for DOT&PF decision makers to manage transportation infrastructure investments. The plan update is an opportunity for you to help inform the plan! Key goals of the plan are:

- To identify and evaluate existing transportation facilities, issues, and needs.
- A plan for developing, maintaining, and funding roads, trails, walking and bicycling facilities, airports, and boat facilities over the next 20 years.
- A prioritized list of projects to assist the DOT&PF when funding opportunities arise.

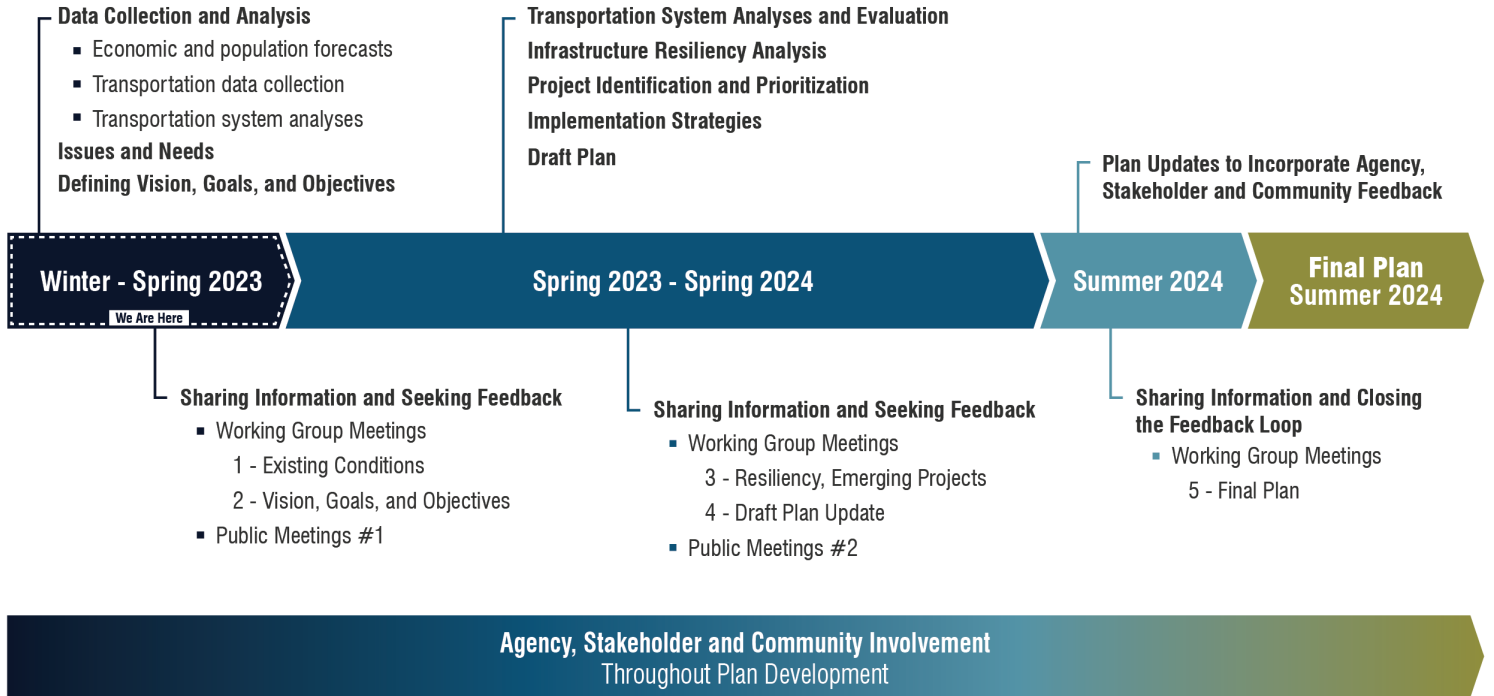
What is a regional transportation plan?
